CHA CHA CHA CHANGES

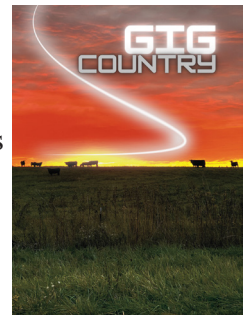
